Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, I would like to know how many (numerical number) 999 calls were received by the London Fire Brigade regarding the incident involving a car and three young boys on Shepiston Lane, Hayes, on the evening of January 26, 2018, between 8:00 PM and 9:30 PM. Additionally, please provide the time of the initial call, the arrival time of the first fire engine at the scene, the time they departed, and the total number of fire engines that responded. Furthermore, please specify the fire station from which these fire engines were dispatched, and if multiple stations attended, kindly list all of them.

Response:

Further to your request, I have contacted the LFB Control team. Details of the incident on the 26 January 2018 are below. However, the number of calls for this incident are unknown as this incident is from 2018. Records are therefore limited.

The time of the initial call was at 21:30:32. The arrival of the first engine at the scene was from Hayes Fire Station at 21:34:31. The time the Hayes Fire station crew departed the scene was 22:07:02. Furthermore, the total number of fire engines that responded was two pumping appliances and a fire rescue unit. These were Hayes, Heathrow and Wembley Fire stations.
