In response to the above, the London Fire Brigade has a cybersecurity e-learning training package,

The course includes the following topic areas:

- Passwords
- Just doesn't look right
- Ransomware
- Social Media
- Internet Security
- Cloud Services & Sharing
- Email accounts
- Devices and Apps
- Offline Security

Detailed below are the numbers of staff who undertook the training in each annual period and the annual cost:

- March 2022 – February 2023 – 953 staff completed the training – annual cost £12,725
- March 2023 – February 2024 – 5,257 staff completed the training – annual cost £12,725
- March 2024 – February 2025 – 3,761 staff completed the training – annual cost £9,544
