In response to the above, please note as the enforcing authority under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order, 2005, (RRO) the Brigade does not provide, or conduct fire risk assessments (FRA) as this is the responsibility of the responsible persons (RP). Whilst on some occasions the RP may provide a copy to the Inspecting Officer (IO) we are under no obligation to retain them.
