Thank you for your correspondence of 20 July 2026 requesting details of all incidents attended by London Fire Brigade in 2025, with particular interest in incidents in Soho and Euston.

The information you have requested is mostly available online and, to provide you with a fast and less formal response, the link to the published information can be accessed using the details below.

A full list of incidents attended by the LFB is published via the London Datastore and can be accessed via these links:

These datasets are updated monthly and contain further details of:

- The type of incident (i.e. fire, false alarm, special service);
- The date and time the incident occurred;
- The property type where the incident took place (such as dwelling, commercial, car);
- The location of the incident (Borough, fire station ground, postcode, USRN, latitude/longitude);
- How long it took the first and second fire engine (pump) to arrive at the incident;

- Where the fire engine(s) were deployed from;
- The number of fire engines that attended the incident;
- The length of time the fire engines stayed at the incident;
- The notional cost of the LFB attending the incident.

You will be able to filter the datasets by location to identify incidents in Soho and Euston specifically.

This information is exempt from disclosure under [section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 Information accessible to applicant by other means](#) as it is already publicly available via the links above.
