- CAVE (Cave Automatic Virtual Environment) systems
- XR, VR or MR rooms
- 180°, 270° or 360° projection environments
- Interactive immersive spaces
- Simulation suites
- Decision theatres

For each installation, please provide:

- Name of the supplier awarded the contract.
- Manufacturer or product brand supplied.
- Brief description of the system.
- Department, faculty, school or business unit using the system.
- Building or campus where installed (where appropriate).
- Date of contract award.
- Date of installation or commissioning.
- Total contract value (excluding VAT where possible).
- Procurement route used (Open Tender, Framework Agreement, Mini Competition, Direct Award, Quotation, etc.).
- Name of the procurement framework used (if applicable).
- Contract or tender reference number.
- Whether there is an ongoing maintenance or support contract and, if so, its expiry date.
- Copies of any publicly releasable tender specification, statement of requirements or contract award notice relating to the procurement.
