I would like to know the callsign, time mobilised, time on scene, time available for all pumps/fire engines and specialist appliances that attended Fencepiece Road, Chigwell on the 14/06/2025. If available- please also provide width, length of building(s) involved and percentage alight.

Thank you for your request for information, which was received on 1 June 2026.

Some of the information you have requested is already publicly available online. Under [Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000](#), public authorities are not required to provide information that is reasonably accessible to applicants by other means.

The London Fire Brigade (LFB) publishes its mobilisation records through the London Datastore, which can be accessed using the following link:

These datasets are updated monthly and contain information including: Incident type, date and time of the incident, property type, location, fire engine response times, fire station(s) from which appliances were mobilised, number of fire engines attending, duration of attendance at the incident.

Please note that LFB did not record the width or length of buildings involved in incidents, nor the percentage of a building affected by fire. Therefore, unable to provide this information.

The specific appliance level detail you have requested individual callsigns and precise mobilisation, on-scene, and available times per appliance is not captured within the London Datastore records. This information would be held within LFB's fire reports and mobilisation reports, which are managed by our Incident Report Team. These reports are chargeable and you would need to be assessed as eligible before purchasing them. For further information on how to request these reports, please visit:

The incident you refer to occurred in Chigwell, which falls within the jurisdiction of Essex County Fire and Rescue Service (ECFRS).
