

Freedom of Information request: Reference number FOI2026/00878

Request:

I am requesting the following information relating to the business Kosher Kingdom located at 7-9 Russell parade, Golders Green Road, NW119Nn

- * The dates of any fire safety audits, inspections or regulatory visits carried out during the five years preceding the fire on 27 May 2026.
- * Copies of any Enforcement Notices, Alterations Notices, Prohibition Notices or other formal fire safety notices issued in relation to the premises.
- * Copies of any records identifying fire safety deficiencies or recommended remedial actions arising from audits or inspections, where disclosure is permitted.
- * The date of the most recent Fire Risk Assessment reviewed by the London Fire Brigade (I understand the assessment itself may be exempt from disclosure).
- * Any records relating to the fire investigation that can now be disclosed, including factual findings on the origin and cause of the fire.
- * If the investigation is still ongoing, confirmation of its current status.

- * Any records relating to fire safety measures for the mixed commercial and residential building, including compartmentation between the commercial premises and the residential flats, where disclosure is permitted.

If any of the requested information is exempt from disclosure, please provide any non-exempt information that can be released and identify the relevant exemption(s) relied upon.

This request relates to the mixed-use building that was affected by the fire on 27 May 2026, comprising the commercial premises and the residential flats above.

Response:

I refer to your request for information, received on 28 July 2026, which has been processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request concerned fire safety records held by the London Fire Brigade (LFB) in relation to the premises at 7–9 Russell Parade, Golders Green Road, London NW11 9NN, occupied by Kosher Kingdom, and the mixed-use building of which it forms part.

LFB holds no records of any fire safety inspections or audits carried out at this address under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 during the five years preceding 27 May 2026. Consequently, we hold no records of any enforcement notices, prohibition notices, or alterations notices issued in relation to the premises, and no records of fire safety deficiencies or recommended remedial actions arising from any such visits. We also hold no records of the date of any Fire Risk Assessment reviewed by LFB in relation to the premises, nor any records relating to fire safety measures or compartmentation for the building.

The London Fire Brigade is the enforcing authority in London for the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005. However, it is not the Brigade's role to undertake or provide fire risk assessments. Responsibility for assessing and managing fire safety risks rests with the responsible person for the premises. Any records relating to the fire investigation including records of the origin and cause of the fire falls outside the scope of a Freedom of Information request. This information is exempt from disclosure under [Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000](#) (information reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means), as it is available through a separate process in the incident report team.
