Request:

1. Are wildfire response vehicles MDT equipped, what Comms equipment do they have?
2. Handheld main scheme radios make and model?

Response:

I refer to your request for information, received on 19 June 2026, which has been processed as a Freedom of Information request.

Question 1 - Are wildfire response vehicles MDT equipped, what Comms equipment do they have?

The Terrain support vehicles have the following comms equipment:

- Each vehicle carries a Handheld air wave radio, (vehicles soon to be upgraded with hand free kits similar to officer cars) Fitted with the Panasonic Touchpad FZ-G2 MDT and an airwave main scheme radio.
- Each vehicle has a mobile phone with the responder app used for mobilising and passing of information notices (i.e. RVP's etc)
- Each vehicle carries a handheld fireground radio for communications on scene.

Question 2 - Handheld main scheme radios make and model?

- The make is Motorola and the model is MDH77PCN6TZ6AN.
